



What is the Foundation's mission?

The Foundation aims to create a bright and productive future for every BGPS student by leveraging cultural, economic, and community resources to enhance their educational experiences.

Community partnerships have strengthened the Battle Ground Education Foundation since its inception in 1994. It is a legacy the Foundation is charged with keeping alive so we may continue to support Battle Ground students for generations to come.

In 2025, the Battle Ground Education Foundation was able to donate over **\$64,000** dollars toward grants and programs benefiting the students of Battle Ground Public Schools. These programs include support of: the Kids in Need Fund, the School Backpack Program, School Resource Officers, the Family and Community Resource Center (FCRC), Student Activity Fees, the Principal Discretionary Fund, and two \$5,000 scholarships.





Through the Kids in Need Fund and the FCRC, the Battle Ground Education Foundation contributed **\$28,000** to enhance the stability and well-being of the children who attend Battle Ground Public Schools and their families.



In 2025, thanks to the generosity of our community at the annual 'Stuff the Bus' event, **850** backpacks were filled with the school supplies students need to make a confident, successful start to their school year.

In partnership with IQ Credit Union, BGEF was able to donate **\$4,200** to provide **900** first graders with a new book to help spark a lifelong love of reading during 2025 Read Across Clark County Celebration. Additionally, the Foundation provided a **\$400** grant to support the Math Challenge enrichment program for elementary school students.



Each year, the Battle Ground Education Foundation donates funds to ensure that students are able to access activities and special programs that can present a financial barrier for families.



In 2025, the Foundation donated **\$7,195** to pay for student activity fees and **\$1,247** for AP test fees so that any student who wanted to play a sport, or participate in a club, or do the work to create the future of their dreams could do so.

During the 2024/25 school year, the Battle Ground Education Foundation supported the critical work that School Resource Officers do by contributing **\$243** to support Red Ribbon Week and **\$480** to help keep the SRO food pantry stocked. The officer's ability to offer a snack to students is often the first way they can lower barriers and start to make the lasting relationships that result in all students feeling safe, secure, and supported while they are at school.



In 2025, the Foundation provided each building principal with **\$500**, totalling **\$8,500** to support students in their schools. This program puts funding directly into the hands of the people that know the immediate needs of students best. In 2025, the Foundation donated an additional **\$4,000** to erase student food service account balances.



The Battle Ground Education Foundation supports students while they are part of Battle Ground Public Schools and beyond.

In 2025, the Foundation awarded two **\$5,000** college scholarships to students seeking to continue their education at the college level.
